Mississippi Steel Processing in Full Production Assists in Tornado Recovery Efforts

(Columbus, MS) Mississippi Steel Processing, LLC's new flat rolled toll processing operation entered full production the first week of April, eight months after breaking ground for the 135,000 ft² facility. Located on the campus of the Severstal Steel Mill in Columbus, Mississippi, MSP provides slitting, cut-to-length, storage and logistics services for customers of Severstal, plus service centers and manufacturers throughout the Southern US and Mexico. MSP handles master coils up to 90,000 lbs., material to 0.625" thick, and produces leveled sheets of up to 84" x 720".

The new MSP facility suffered no damage from the ferocious tornados that devastated parts of northeastern Mississippi in late April. In response to the tragedy, Severstal and MSP leaders coordinated donation efforts and purchased supplies for recovery efforts in nearby Smithville, MS and Hackleburg, AL which were devastated by a massive twister.
